TO THE GOSPEL

- God loved us before we were formed in our mother's womb and intended for us to be His partners in bringing heaven to earth. (Psalm 139:13-14, Ephesians 1:4)
- When man rebelled, there was a permanent separation from God, and man was subject to His judgement for sin and the introduction of death. Our human nature is sinful, and the wages of sin is death physical, spiritual, and eternal. (Romans 6:23)
- God's justice demands death for sin. (John 8:24)
- Those who don't think about their accountability to God or do not believe in the spiritual realities are spiritually dead and deceived. (Ephesians 2:1)
- Jesus came to restore the relationship between God and man and defeat death. He fully knows you, loves you, values you, and has a great plan for your life. His kindness leads us to repentance. He is rich in mercy and compassion. (2 Timothy 1:10, Ephesians 2:4, Jeremiah 29:11, Romans 2:4)



- Satan comes only to steal, kill, and destroy. Jesus came that we may have life and have it to the full. (John 10:10)
- Jesus reveals the character and nature of God. In the words of Jesus, "Anyone who has seen Me, has seen the Father" (John 14:9).
- After Jesus died and rose again, defeating death and reconciling God and man, the Holy Spirit came to establish God's kingdom on earth, reclaim the nations, and glorify Jesus. (John 16:7-14)
- Salvation requires one to recognise their need to be reconciled and receive forgiveness from Jesus. (1 John 1:9)
- Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. This is God's will. (Romans 10:13, 1 Timothy 2:3-4)
- Since we are His true children, we qualify to share His treasures, for indeed, we are heirs of God. Joined with Christ, we also inherit all that He is and all that He has.
